It is Probable That the Tree of Life Was an _____ Tree

- In [Gen. 8:11](#) Noah sends a dove from the ark and when it returns it has an olive leaf in its mouth – a sign of life.
- In [Ex. 27:20](#) The lights on the lampstand in the tabernacle were fueled by olive oil – they burned “always”
- In [Ps. 52:8](#) David likens his life to an “olive tree in the house of God,” signifying his life could never be destroyed.
- [Zechariah 14:4](#) When Jesus returns to set up His eternal kingdom, He returns first to the Mount of Olives
- [Rom 11:24](#) tells us that we are grafted into the Olive Tree when we are saved.

It is Probable That the Tree of Knowledge of Good and Evil Was a _____ Tree

- Scripture refers to the vine tree - [Eze. 15:2,6](#), [Num. 6:4](#), [Jg. 9:13](#). Jesus said, I am the true vine, [Jn. 15:1](#)
- There is only one fruit _____ in the Bible – grapes!
- [Numbers 6:3](#) – Nazarite vow.
- Grapes are associated with _____ – [Matthew 26:27-28](#), [Genesis 49:11](#), [Deut. 32:14](#)
- Eating blood is forbidden – before the law, [Gen. 9:4](#). Under the law, [Lev. 17:12](#). After the law, [Acts 15:28](#)

Whatever the case, Adam and Eve’s _____ changed the day they ate of the fruit.

[Genesis 2:17](#) But of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, thou shalt not eat of it: for in the day that thou eatest thereof thou shalt surely die. Adam and Eve’s _____ died that day. Their blood and flesh changed as well. An unsaved man is no different today. He is a walking dead man. Our spirit needs to be born again, [Rom. 8:16, 11](#)

Adam’s Original State

1. He Had a _____ Circulatory System

- First mention of “life” is in [Genesis 1:20](#)
- Possibly water. Why water? Water is a type of the Holy Spirit - [Genesis 2:7](#), [John 7:38](#), [Revelation 22:17](#)

2. He Had Different _____

- There are different kinds of flesh - [1 Corinthians 15:39-40](#)
- He may have had a body like Jesus’ resurrection body - [Luke 24:39](#), [John 20:26-27](#), [Gen. 2:23](#), [1 Cor. 15:43-50](#)

When we are raptured, we will not only leave everything we own behind, but we will leave our sinful blood behind too. We will also receive glorified bodies – perhaps like the one Adam had. [Philippians 3:21](#)

So, if Adam and Eve had different blood (or no blood) before the fall, the question then becomes, “Where did they get the blood we inherited?” They had to get it orally. They had to take it through the mouth from the forbidden blood of the grape. Therefore, we inherited sinful blood. We all need a blood transfusion!

Have you ever wondered why God requires blood shed for sin? Among other things, it’s because we have a sin problem that’s connected with our blood. After Adam and Eve sinned, God shed the blood of a lamb to cover their nakedness (*wine is connected with nakedness in the Bible* [Hab.2:15](#)) and man was required to do so since that time. Even Abel knew to bring a blood sacrifice before God - [Gen. 4:3](#). Thank God for providing an eternal blood sacrifice! [Heb. 9:12-14](#)

Jesus first public miracle was to turn water to wine. This may have been to typify mans fall as well as show man’s need for the pure of Christ blood. **Moses first public miracle** was to turn water to wine which brought forth death.

4. One of **Noah's** boys is under a curse (Ham)
5. One of **Noah's** boys is a type of Christ (Shem)
6. **Noah's** nakedness was revealed after drinking wine – [Gen. 9:20](#)
